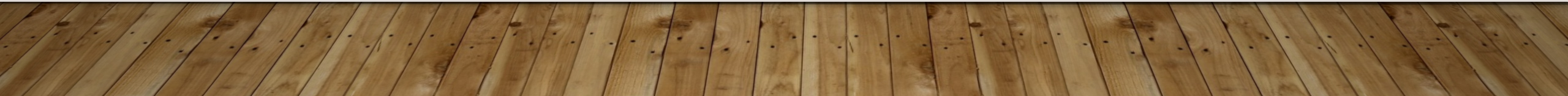


LEARNING TO DRAW IS LEARNING TO SEE

September 9, 2015

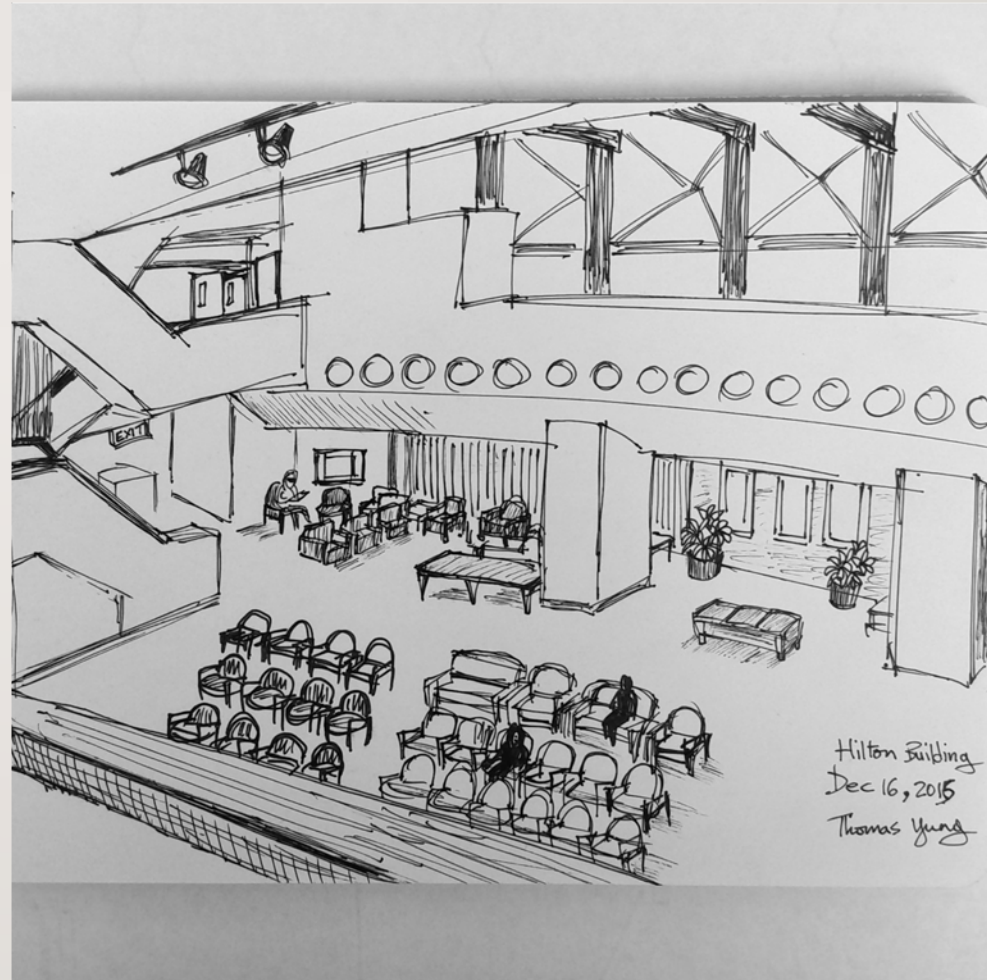
After a series of meetups prior, we went to this quiet and serene courtyard at St. Mary's Hospital. Patients would often be seen here waiting and praying for their loved ones.
